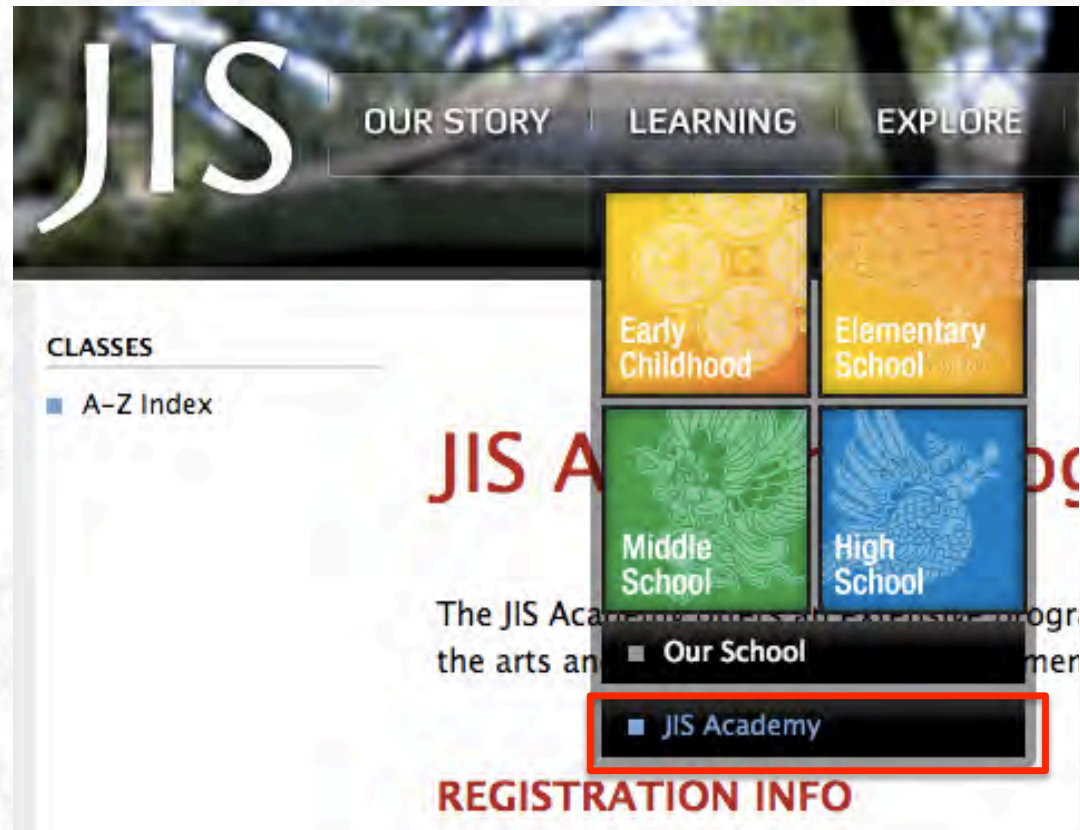

A Typical G9 Day

JIS Graduation Requirements (minimum 24 credits)

- English = 4 credits
- Mathematics = 2 credits
- Science = 2 credits
- Social Studies = 2 credits
- Modern Languages = 2 credits
- PE = 2 credits (1 grade 9, 1 grade 10)
- Health = 0.5 credits (grade 10)
- Creative Arts = 2 credits (grade 9)
- “Electives” (a misnomer!) = 7.5 credits

Subjects with different levels

CA: Teachers may recommend “2’s” for grade 9 (e.g. Art 2). Most students will take 2 credits of CA in grade 9.

Modern Languages: must be in Level 2 for IB SL and Level 3 for IB HL track

Science: a “Foundations” option available for PALS. Mirrors regular PALS: students will have the same access to grade 10 courses and beyond (good for late science developers)

Mathematics: Recommendations from grade 8 math teacher – 3 levels

New Requirements for Indonesian Passport holders only (G9)

- Indonesian Language, Literature & Civics = 4 credits
- Religious education at home
